• FLORIDA BIRTH CERTIFICATE •

Osceola County Tax Collector has partnered with the Florida Department of Health, Office of Vital Statistics to issue certified copies of Florida birth certificates to eligible individuals. Osceola County residents needing their birth certificate to obtain a driver license or identification card will now be able to complete both transactions at the same office.

The fee for a Florida Birth Certificate issued by the Tax Collector office is \$23.25. Any additional copies will be \$8.00 each at the time of original issuance.

OBTAINING A FLORIDA BIRTH CERTIFICATE

1. PICTURE ID

YOU MUST BRING ONE VALID/CURRENT PICTURE IDENTIFICATION (ID) TO APPLY FOR A FLORIDA BIRTH CERTIFICATE. If you are a parent requesting a copy of your child's Florida birth certificate, you must bring your valid and current picture ID. Acceptable forms of picture ID include:

- Driver License
- State Identification Card
- Passport
- Military Identification Card

2. ELIGIBILITY

Determine your eligibility (relationship) to receive a Florida birth certificate. You must meet one (1) of the following criteria:

- Be the child named on the Florida birth certificate AND 18 years of age or older, or
- Be the recorded or listed parent of the person named on the Florida birth certificate.

Birth Records Older than 100 Years:

Any person of legal age may be issued a copy of a birth record except for those under seal for a birth event that occurred over 100 years ago.

Birth Records Under Seal:

Birth Records under seal by reason of adoption, paternity determination or court order cannot be order in the usual manner.

3. CERTIFICATE HOLDER INFORMATION

Be prepared to provide information about the person named on the Florida birth certificate:

- Full name of person at birth and any subsequent legal name changes
- Date of birth
- City or county of birth
- Mother's full name including her maiden surname
- Father's full name (if his name is on the record)

4. APPLICANT INFORMATION

Be prepared to provide information about the person obtaining the Florida birth certificate:

- Full name
- Relationship to person named on the certificate (father, mother, self, etc.)
- Mailing address (include city, state and zip code)
- Daytime phone number

5. APPLICATION FOR FLORIDA BIRTH RECORD

Save time and complete the Application for Birth Record prior to visiting one of our offices.
